Gene Warber Fishing Area

Gene Warber, 66, passed away June 25, 2013. Gene dedicated over 40 years of his life to the advancement of the youth of the Boy Scouts of America. His last 15 years were in the service of the Tidewater Council, Boy Scout of America.

In honor of his tireless efforts, in support of youth development, the Gene Warber Memorial Fishing Area is being established at the Pipsico Scout Reservation in Surry County, VA.

The completed project will include a nearly 1,000 square foot partially-covered fishing pier, an activity shelter with power and water, access from the main service road, and foot-path access from a scenic Lake Beazley overlook. This project is estimated to cost approximately \$53,000. Funds raised in excess of the goal shall be used to further develop the memorial project and fund a maintenance endowment for the Pipsico Scout Reservation.
