POWDER HORN: It's a **resource course** designed to introduce and expose Boy Scouting, Venturing, Sea Scouting, both adult and youth (over the age of 14) leaders to the activities and resources necessary to operate a successful and safe outdoor/high adventure unit-level program.

HOW TO REGISTER AND PAY YOUR FEE

1. REGISTER AND PAY ONLINE: (The preferred method) Go to https://tidewater.tentaroo.com/ . If you or your unit do not have a Tentaroo account, then create your free "Individual/Group" account, fill out all personal information, select this event and follow the instructions on the web site to register and pay. A 3% convenience fee will be added to pay for credit card or e-check processing and Tentaroo system use.			
2. REGISTER ONLINE, BUT PAY AT OFFICE: Register online, choose \$0.00 payment and use this form to pay at the council.

WHEN:	July 28 – 30, 2017
WHERE:	Pipsico Scout Reservation
FEE:	\$170 per participant through May 1 st and then \$185 after that until June 15. The first 50 participants will be accepted. After that a wait list will be created.
WHO SHOULD ATTEND:	Both youth and adults interested in learning about local high adventure resources to improve your unit outdoor program. This is open to all scouting programs (Boy Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts, Explorers etc.). Youth participants should be 14 years old at the time of the course (or 13 and completed the 8 th grade).
PREREQUISITES:	- All participants (youth and adult) must take Venturing Youth Protection as well as Hazardous Weather, Safety Afloat, Safe Swim Defense, and Climb on Safely which are all available on-line at your training page at https://my.scouting.org/ . Youth participants should be 14 years old at the time of the course (or 13 and completed the 8 th grade).
WHAT TO BRING:	Be prepared to camp out for two nights. Bring your personal camping gear and a camp chair. Bring a notebook and pencil or pen. If you have any "cool" camping or outdoor gear – bring it, we can do show and tell. If you have been on an outback high adventure trek – bring some details, pictures, planning documents etc. – we can use those for our planning exercise.
