Choose desired Merit Badges to fill as many slots as preferred.

Session times as follows:

Sessions 1 - 4 are Day 1 and Sessions 5 - 8 are Day 2

Sessions 1 and 5: 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Sessions 2 and 6: 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Sessions 3 and 7: 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Sessions 4 and 8: 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Some badges will have two-hour slots, while others will have four-hour slots. For example: American Cultures runs from 8am to 10am, so you would only be able to select other merit badges that day whose times are from 10am onward. Many badges require attendance at both the September and December dates. These have "AND" in between the dates.

Most badges will have requirements that must be completed outside of MBU sessions, either before, in between, or after the September and December dates. Check with your Merit Badge Counselor for any questions on requirement completions.

There are eight session to the 2018 MBU. Each session is 2 hours in length.

It is expected that the scouts make the most of their time and fill all sessions.

Scouts should be picked up if they do not have a session.

Scouts will not be allowed to roam around the church.

Scouts will be expected to help the counselors to clean up the class room at the end of the day.

Expectations Merit Badge University

Merit Badges University gives Scouts an opportunity to learn about skills, history, culture, and different career fields. It is more than a check in the box on to earn a Scout Rank. Merit Badge University (MBU) is 2 days of Merit Badge (MB) sessions with 90 days between sessions. This allows Scouts to complete requirements that are not practical inside a classroom. Requirements can be completed either before MBU or during the 90 days between sessions.

Some MB sessions will be partials, but Scouts can follow up with the MB counselor and complete the MB after MBU. Please look at the requirements needed to complete each MB and do what you can prior to attending MBU. If the requirement states approval from MB counselor prior to completing the requirement MBU staff can connect the Scout to the counselor in advance.

If the requirement states to demonstrate or discuss, come to MBU ready to demonstrate or discuss by doing research in advance. Merit Badges will be earned based on completion of all requirements; partial effort will result in a partial Merit Badge completion.

Below is a general list of what will and will not be covered for MBU, this list is not exclusive, please contact MB staff if you have any questions. For any requirements not completed at MBU bring a letter from your Scoutmaster.
