

Leadership training is a major part of Scouting. The Trainer's EDGE is BSA's trainer development course which teaches Scout leaders how to conduct an effective training session using BSA's preferred training approaches, including the EDGE method. In addition, this course provides Scouters opportunities to prepare and deliver an oral presentation, and develop new skills using hands-on experience in methods and media. This course is required for all NYLT and Wood Badge staff, and should be considered mandatory for all unit leaders to effectively teach and train youth. All Trainer's EDGE participants should come prepared to give a 10-15 minute presentation on any Scouting topic. Lunch will be provided for those who register for The Fundamentals of Training (check-in starts at 7:30am, class starts at 8:00am) AND Trainer's EDGE (class starts at 12:30pm).
