Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) is the Cub Scout leader training required for any Cub Scout den or pack outdoor event, including pack camping overnighters and Webelos den overnighters. BALOO training is comprised of two components—an online component and an overnight, hands-on outdoor component. Both components must be completed to qualify as a "TRAINED" Cub Scout or Webelos outdoor leader. Completion of both parts of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a pack camping overnighter and Webelos den camping overnighters.
