

## BASIC ADULT LEADER OUTDOOR ORIENTATION (BALOO)



Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) is the Cub Scout leader training required for any Cub Scout den or pack outdoor event, including pack camping overnights and Webelos den overnights. BALOO training is comprised of two components—an online component and an overnight, hands-on outdoor component. Both components must be completed to qualify as a “TRAINED” Cub Scout or Webelos outdoor leader. Completion of both parts of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a pack camping overnighter and Webelos den camping overnighters.

<b>WHAT TO BRING:</b>	This course requires overnight camping, and Cub Family Camp registrants taking this BALOO course will be sleeping and eating with their packs/dens, except for lunch Saturday. If you are not coming to Cub Family Camp with your pack, you will camp/eat with a pack identified for you. Except for lunch Saturday, meals <b>are not</b> provided by the course staff nor Cub Family Camp staff. BALOO participants should bring tent, ground cover, mess kit, camp chair, sleeping gear, other personal camping equipment, Cub Scout Leader Book. Be prepared for cold and/or wet weather.
