Face Masks at Day Camp

How-To Use a Face Mask

- 1. Write on the paper bag the Scout's First Name, Last Name, and Pack.
- 2. Wash and sanitize hands before touching mask.
- 3. Open paper bag.
- 4. Remove facemask from bag, holding the sides of the mask. Do not touch the front of the mask to remove.
- 5. Wear masks whenever we are unable to maintain six feet social distancing. Masks should cover nose, mouth, and chin.
- 6. Whenever we are NOT wearing masks, fold facemask and put back in paper bag (see pictures) to keep it clean and preserved.
- 7. Perform hand hygiene after touching mask.

Safety Tips

- ✓ Facemasks may be worn for **5 days** if intact.
- ✓ Do not touch facemask while wearing. If mask is touched, perform hand hygiene.
- ✓ If you are having difficulty breathing, remove the facemask. Do not pull it down below chin or take partially off. This may result in contamination.
- Keep paper bag and facemask intact so they can be used throughout the week.
- ✓ Discard and replace facemask and/or paper bag if they are visibly contaminated, damaged, wet, or hard to breathe through.
- ✓ Leave facemask in Scout's utility bucket or Day Pack to ensure it is at camp every day.
