

# Face Masks at Day Camp

## How-To Use a Face Mask

1. Write on the paper bag the Scout's First Name, Last Name, and Pack.
2. Wash and sanitize hands before touching mask.
3. Open paper bag.
4. Remove facemask from bag, holding the sides of the mask. Do not touch the front of the mask to remove.
5. Wear masks whenever we are unable to maintain six feet social distancing. Masks should cover nose, mouth, and chin.
6. Whenever we are NOT wearing masks, fold facemask and put back in paper bag (see pictures) to keep it clean and preserved.
7. Perform hand hygiene after touching mask.

## Safety Tips

- ✓ Facemasks may be worn for **5 days** if intact.
- ✓ Do not touch facemask while wearing. If mask is touched, perform hand hygiene.
- ✓ If you are having difficulty breathing, remove the facemask. Do not pull it down below chin or take partially off. This may result in contamination.
- ✓ Keep paper bag and facemask intact so they can be used throughout the week.
- ✓ Discard and replace facemask and/or paper bag if they are visibly contaminated, damaged, wet, or hard to breathe through.
- ✓ Leave facemask in Scout's utility bucket or Day Pack to ensure it is at camp every day.
