


Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training September 17 & 24, 2016

Working as a patrol, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Leader Specific, this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Scout Teams in order to be considered "trained".

Every leader should bring writing materials, a three-ring binder, and individual camping equipment referenced in the Boy Scout Handbook. Handouts and meals are provided.
