

This is a combined course. Working in dens and patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Webelos and scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the Webelos and Arrow of Light and the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Specifics this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Scout Teams, in order to be considered "basic trained".

What Do You Need to Bring To this Training? This is an outdoor class, please dress for the weather.

Every leader should bring writing materials, a three-ring binder, a chair, overnight camping and cooking equipment. Provided will be, handouts and food for meals, lunch, dinner and breakfast. Bring your own snacks.
