The purpose of Trainer's EDGE is to provide and help develop the trainer's platform skills. It is meant to raise the level of skill a trainer brings to the learning experience. Only practice can polish these skills, but this course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media. This is part of a continuous process of updating trainers with the latest training methods, principles, and technologies.
