



ABOUT THE COURSE: The Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) course builds and expands on the concepts and themes introduced in Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training and Varsity Coach Position-Specific Training, and provides Scouters with the confidence to take youth into the outdoors.

HOW TO REGISTER AND PAY YOUR FEE

1. REGISTER AND PAY ONLINE: (The preferred method) Go to http://tentaroo.com/tidewater . If you or your unit do not have a Tentaroo account, then create your free "Individual/Group" account, fill out all personal information, select this event and follow the instructions on the web site to register and pay.
