

## **Den Chief Training**



The Den Chief Training Conference combines fun and enjoyment with an excellent character building experience. Participants will learn leadership, organization, and most importantly, how to work with Cub Scouts. The course identifies Den Chief responsibilities and tasks, and describes the Den Chief's relationship to the adult Den Leaders and how that relates to the Den Chief's activities with the den. Boy Scouts wishing to become Den Chiefs to a Cub Scout den will take this course as part of their training to become a Den Chief. It is also for registered adult leaders who want to learn the duties and role of Den Chiefs. We recommend youth students be First Class Scouts (or Second Class Scouts close to advancing to First Class). Den Chiefs need this training to be considered "trained".
