Dear Prospective Participants, Unit Leaders, and Parents,

Welcome to the National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) website! I personally want to take this opportunity to tell you how I feel about NYLT and how it will be of benefit to you, your Scouts, and your unit.

NYLT is an intense, six-day training course for Scouts, Sea Scouts, and Venturers. Our course will be held over two weekends (November 9-11 and November 15-17, 2019). **Attendance is required both weekends.** This course provides Scouts with the leadership skills they need to be truly effective. It is the most advanced youth leader training that Scouting offers at the council level. NYLT features instruction in modern leadership skills and philosophies that can be used at home, school, on the job, and, of course, the Scout's own unit! A trained and dedicated staff of youth leaders and instructors work closely with qualified adult mentors to put on this course.

When participants arrive, they will be organized into patrols. Through a range of activities, events, games, and adventures, NYLT participants will work and play together as they put into action the best that Scouting has to offer. The course is set up to represent a month in the life of a Scout troop. Patrols will experience the stages of team development and will discover that leadership requires vision, goals, and planning. Participants are provided a toolbox of leadership skills.

As the youth progress through different skills and environments, our units encounter the most difficult, complicated, and sophisticated leadership challenges. Participants and their NYLT patrols get firsthand opportunities to practice and experience relevant leadership skills for developing highly-effective teams to assist them in handling these challenges. NYLT will strengthen the relationship between the youth and the unit leader and prepare the youth to implement a youth-led, youth-run unit.

In order to maintain the high quality of the NYLT program, each course is limited to 48 participants. Apply early! National policy is that all Scouts BSA participants must be 13 to 17 years old and hold the rank of First Class. For 2019 only, an exception will be granted for girls registered in Scouts BSA to attend NYLT without first achieving the First Class rank, but they must still meet age requirements, attend Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST), and have their Scoutmaster's recommendation. Venturers and Sea Scouts must be between 14 and 20 years old. All candidates should be in a position of leadership or will be candidates for leadership positions in the near future. Youth selected to attend will be notified no later than October 14, 2019. All participants must have completed an Introduction to Leadership Skills course for their respective program (Crews, Ships, or Troops).
