Special Guest Speaker Programming

- *Army Corps of Engineers, 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: Learn about the US Army Corps of Engineers
 missions and what engineering projects the Norfolk District has in our portfolio. Additionally, find out about
 what the Norfolk District does for maintaining and cleaning the regions waterways and safe practices while using
 these waters.
- *Battleship Wisconsin Radio Club, Battleship Wisconsin 03 Level, ALL DAY: Join the Radio Club members as they demonstrate the variety of communication equipment used on our Battleship Wisconsin- radio operating positions, two with modern equipment and one true WWII radio set up, that have the capability of communicating worldwide. There will also be a morse code position where the Scouts can actually send messages using a morse code key.
- 3) *Children's Museum of Virginia, 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: Join the crews as they explore the science of KEVA planks. Build structures by simply stacking the planks- no glue, no connectors. From preschoolers to architects, each person builds at his or her own skill level. Try one of the challenges provided, use your imagination and compete with friends.
- 4) *Mariner's Museum, 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: The Mariners' Museum is home to the USS Monitor Center, and is surrounded by the 550-acre Mariners' Museum Park. Scouts will have Park items, navigational tools, and other fun items to explore the help understand what our unique Museum and Park are all about.
- 5) *Norfolk Botanical Garden, 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: Practice your field biology with Norfolk Botanical Garden as you learn about the plants and animals who call the Garden home, and then make your own small flower press to take home.
- 6) *Norfolk Department of Utilities, 3rd Floor Shark Lab/Horseshoe Crab Cove Area, ALL DAY: Beware of the Grease Grinch this holiday season! Scouts will learn from the Norfolk Department of Utilities what not to put down the drains. Saving us all from costly repairs and environmental disasters.
- *National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), 3rd Floor NOAA Hallway, ALL DAY: Join your local National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) friends today in learning about NOAA careers on land, at sea, and in the air. You can also play with a sounding box to make your own nautical chart, participate in gumby suit races, and see how a compass works!
- *Norfolk Police Harbor Patrol, 3rd Floor NOAA Main Hallway, ALL DAY: The Norfolk Police Department Harbor Patrol Unit will be showing sonar equipment used by divers and boats during search and rescue/evidence recovery operations. We will also have public safety dive gear as worn by our police divers set up for demonstration.
- 9) *Norfolk Naval Shipyard Outreach/Shipyard/Naval Civilian Managers Association (NNSY/NCMA), 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: Meet the NNSY team members as they share experiences working at our local shipyard including community youth outreach programming such as LEGO Mindstorm Robotics, snap circuits, and more!
- **10)** *Sail Nauticus, 3rd Floor Main Hallway, ALL DAY: Meet the Sail Nauticus crew as they share hands-on activities demonstrating basic sailing techniques.
- 11) *Tidewater Community College, Shark Lab/Horseshoe Crab Cove Area, ALL DAY: Meet students and instructors from Tidewater Community College to learn about their mechatronic and manufacturing careers.

- 12) *U.S. Navy Fleet Forces Command, 3rd Floor U.S. Navy Stewards of the Sea Exhibit, ALL DAY: The Stewards of the Sea: Defending Freedom, Protecting the Environment exhibit includes hands-on activities, interactive games and exciting videos. Scan the horizon through virtual "Big Eye" binoculars to look for whales, pretend to be a Sailor looking for enemy submarines, and hear how whale calls sound underwater.
- 13) *Virginia Zoo, 3rd Floor VISTA, ALL DAY: Look for clues with the Zoo! Join the Virginia Zoo as we unlock the secrets left behind by animals revealing how they eat, move, and survive in their environment.

- *Shark Lab and Horseshoe Crab Cove, 3rd Floor Aquariums, ALL DAY: Come and visit with our bamboo sharks, horseshoe crabs and other aquatic friends.
- *Battleship Wisconsin Opening Flag Ceremony, Battleship Wisconsin Fantail, 10:30-11: Join us as we celebrate our 10th Annual Scout Day by raising our nation's ensign aboard the historic US Navy ship, the Battleship Wisconsin.
- *Science on a Sphere Program, 3rd Floor Science on a Sphere (SOS) Exhibit, 11-11:30, 4-4:30: Check out our NOAA exhibit featuring datasets projected on a hovering globe that focus on major ecological events and how human impact affects them.
- *Great Guns of Fire Program, 3rd Floor VISTA, 11-11:30, 1-1:30: Take part in hands-on experiments to demonstrate the physics of how the Battleship Wisconsin 16 inch guns operate.
