Jamboree Leadership Positions Qualifications.

- All Leaders
 - Current YPT
 - Agree to be guided by the Scout Oath and Law and will follow the Jamboree Code of Conduct
 - Attend Jamboree meetings and work-up weekend(s).
- Scoutmaster
 - Must be at least 21 years of age by the first day of Jamboree
 - Currently serving or have served as a Scoutmaster
 - Leads participants on pre-Jamboree training
 - Responsible for proper behavior and conduct of troop members.
 - Receives report from SPL on bed checks and reports results to subcamp staff.
- First Assistant Scoutmaster
 - Must be at least 21 years of age by the first day of Jamboree
 - Currently serving or have served as a Scoutmaster
 - Responsible for program and activities.
 - Assists in Jamboree promotion rallies and recruiting youth.
- Second Assistant Scoutmaster
 - Must be at least 18 years of by the first day of Jamboree
 - Assists in Jamboree promotion rallies and recruiting youth.
 - Working through and with the quartermaster and senior patrol leader, trains and oversees the troop's tasks of drawing food and food supplies, preparation and serving of food, and cleaning up.
 - Responsible for care and neat appearance of equipment and campsite.
- Third Assistant Scoutmaster
 - Must be at least 18 years of by the first day of Jamboree
 - Responsible for troop first aid and contacts the subcamp medical officer on serious cases.
 - Maintains the general morale of the troop, including the distribution of mail and other communications.
 - Responsible for training and providing oversight for sustainability, recycling, and trash management within the unit.
