

COURSE NST15-596-22 (Spring 2022) 5-Day Program over 2 Weekends
April 8-10 and April 30-May 1, 2022

THE PURPOSE: 21st Century Wood Badge is the advanced training program for all BSA Leadership (Cub Scout, Boy Scout, and Venturing Leaders). Wood Badge is designed to train adult volunteer leaders and professional Scouters using the latest leadership skills. Techniques and skills learned will help you to be a better leader. Since 1919, Wood Badge continues to be the preeminent leadership training offered by the Boy Scouts of America.

WHO MAY ATTEND WOOD BADGE: To attend a Wood Badge course, Scouters must:

- 1. Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America and age 18 or older. There is no tenure requirement.
- 2. Have completed the basic position-specific training courses for your Scouting role.
- 3. Be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment. All participants are required to complete the Annual Health and Medical Record; Parts A, B, and C are required, which includes a physical. Part C is required for everyone, including people who are not present for more than 72 hours.

Because of the advanced nature of this training, the requirements above may not be waived.

<u>PLACE/DATES:</u> Wood Badge Course **NST15-596-22** will be held at the Pipsico Scout Reservation near Surry, Virginia, on Friday, April 8 – Sunday, April 10 and Saturday, April 30 – Sunday, May 1, 2022. Participants <u>MUST</u> attend <u>both weekends</u> of the course activities to complete the practical phase of the training.

<u>COURSE FEE</u>: \$300 per participant. A \$50 deposit is required upon <u>acceptance</u>. The fee includes all food for the first weekend and second weekend, program supplies, and a course T-shirt. Scholarships are available to help lessen the financial burden. Assistance may be available through several sources such as your unit, chartered partner, employer, or the VFW. Typical scholarships are one-half of the application fee, and submission deadlines vary.
