- 1. A concrete plan by March 1, 2024, for Cub Scout summer Resident Camp (constrained by (1) Webelos arrive on Thursday; (2) Cub Scouts arrive on Friday; (3) all check out Sunday morning; and (4) summer camp staff will be available to implement plan), including:
 - a. Theme;
 - b. Patch design;
 - c. T-shirt design;
 - d. Program schedule, rotation, and activities;
 - e. Evening program; and
 - f. Scouts Own
- 2. Suggestions regarding the proper number of Cub Scout Day Camps, dates, and locations, taking into account participant numbers and volunteer time demand.
- 3. Suggestions for additions or subtractions to program calendar for Cub Scouts.
- 4. Suggestions for actions that can assist and accelerate recruiting of new Cub Scouts, including what Cub Scout parents desire, how to best reach them, etc.
