



# CREW INFORMATION

The event is Saturday, August 3rd at Mount Trashmore Park.

At the Water Lantern Festival, we aim to help participants remember loved ones, start over and have a memorable experience. Creating this experience is not possible without our local workers! Local workers can work one of two shifts or both.



<b>Set Up Crew:</b>	Times: 10:00 AM- 2:00 PM	Shift Pay: <b>\$48</b> per individual
<p>The Set-up crew will report to the event coordinator at the beginning of the shift, where they will help set up our check-in tent, 10x10 booths, and flags. The crew will then help put together our lantern kits and help to put away all other set-up materials.</p>		

<b>Event Crew:</b>	Times: 4:00 PM- 12:00 AM	Shift Pay: <b>\$96</b> per individual
<p>The Event Crew will report to the event coordinator at the beginning of the shift, where they will be assigned to help with tasks throughout the event. Crew members will help check in guests, give guests lantern kits, and keep the park clean throughout the event. At the end of the shift, all crew members will help to leave the park better than we found it and help us take down the 10x10 booths and flags and count inventory. We will also have pizza for all members during this shift.</p>		

## Payment Options:

Individuals:	Crew members sign up individually through a link. Payment is made to each individual separately.
Groups:	Groups will sign up through a contract sent to the group leader. As well as an online waiver per individual. Payment is a lump sum given to the group leader at the end of the shift.

All payments are made at the end of each shift as a written check, no exceptions.

## Requirements:

- Dependable, on-time, trustworthy
- Can work on your feet for hours at a time
- Crew members must be 15 years of age or older.
- Participants must work the whole shift to receive full payment.
- Receiving shift payment is each groups/individuals responsibility.
