COUNTRY WESTERN FORMAL ATTIRE

- Boots: Polished cowboy boots (exotic leathers like ostrich or lizard if you want extra flair). No scuffs—think dress boots.
- Accessories:
 - Belt with a decorative buckle.
 - Tie (bolo tie is traditional Western formal, but a silk necktie or even no tie with a sharp shirt/jacket also works).
 - Hat: A clean felt cowboy hat (often black or silverbelly).
- Extra polish: Western-style vest, cufflinks, or a string tie for a vintage formal vibe.
